End of lockdown

- Is it not inappropriate to be hasty in relaxing?

Contract formalities

- What happens to new and expiring contracts, and will allowances be made for people on, for example, DOCT contracts who have been unable to carry out their work? Will exceptional extensions be possible?

Travel

Teleworking

- Will special parental leave allowed for parents of young children who are not returning to school before September?

- What does CERN plan to do to ensure social distancing in offices, and what measures are being taken to avoid overcrowding in public spaces such as WCs and restaurants?

Financial impact

- How does the situation affect CERN's budget, and what can we expect for the future?

School

- Will it be possible for families living in France to take their children to school in Switzerland?

Jardin des Particules

- What plans are being made to reopen the Jardin des Particules, and will parents be reimbursed for the whole time it is closed?
