


CHIPP EB since August 2009 (1)

The EB met 7 times and dealt with the following issues:

- Better connection and networking to science policy and funding agencies (Round Table on Swiss representation in international bodies; consultation about SCNAT membership)
- Presentation of a new funding instrument extending the scope of FORCE to 'Large Infrastructures' – to the State Secretary for Education and Research (Dell'Ambrogio)
- Preparation of the visit of Federal Councillor Burkhalter at CERN (August 2010)
- Centre for Advanced Studies in Particle Physics: preparation and submission of the Annual Report 2009 to SUK; preparation and submission of the request for extending the project into 2012 (granted); first preparation for a follow-up request for 2013-2016
- Joint M&O request for the LHC experiments at CERN 2010: preparation and submission of the request (granted)

- Attribution of CHIPP Prize also in 2010



The Board:

- has decided to update / complement the existing Roadmap by preparing a 'Memorandum on the Implementation of the Swiss Road Map on Particle Physics'
- has collected the financial information for updating and extending the long term planning of Swiss participations in projects (→ State Secretariat)
- has synchronised the submission of the FORCE requests to the fall dead-line of SNF
- has elected Klaus Kirch as EB member to substitute Antonio Ereditato (who has been appointed to the Forschungsrat of SNF)
- has discussed ProDoc implementation and a Swiss-wide educational programme for physics
- will discuss (tomorrow) the possible membership of CHIPP in SCNAT






Future improvements:
