New horizons in black hole physics

One of the consequences of General Relativity is that vacuum black holes are remarkably simple macroscopic objects. They are thus ideal laboratories to test the underlying theory and to search for new degrees of freedom. I will discuss recent progress in black hole spectroscopy and in our understanding of black hole environments using gravitational-wave observations.
