How to get to Quy Nhon

International flights arrive in Ho Chi Minh City (IATA code: SGN) or Hanoi (HAN). From there you have to take a domestic flight to Phu Cat (UIH) located about 35 km north of downtown Quy Nhon.

Transfer in Ho Chi Minh City

In Ho Chi Minh City you have to transfer from the international to the domestic terminal.

Changing terminals proved to be very easy: after immigration and baggage claim you leave the international terminal through its only exit and follow the signs to the domestic terminal, approx. 500 m on a shaded sidewalk. Once at the domestic terminal locate the check-in counters of your airline, check in and go upstairs to security check and the boarding gates.
















Transfer in Hanoi

In Hanoi you have to transfer from the International Terminal (T2) to the Domestic Terminal (T1). You can use the free Shuttle bus.

Follow the signs to go out of the terminal building (you are arriving in International Terminal, so the sign will say "**Shuttle Bus to T1**"):



It's a 5 minute ride. The distance is only 1.5 km but there is no sidewalk, so it is not recommended to walk.

Arrival in Quy Nhon

Arriving in Phu Cat is also easy: it is a modern and small airport. Claim your luggage and exit – when leaving the airport building staff may check the luggage receipt on your ticket, so better have it ready in advance. For the conference there will be a shuttle service between the airport and the hotels. We were greeted by ICISE staff and brought to our hotel in downtown Quy Nhon (50 minutes).
