Operations Coordination highlights (2)

Accounting TF

HEPscore integration and deployment aspects discussed in a meeting on Nov 25

Authorization WG

- IAM users & AuthZ WG pre-GDB, Nov 8-9, summary in Dec GDB
- Dedicated meetings to decide the details of the token workflows involving Rucio and/or FTS
- IAM VOMS in production for CMS and used for ATLAS SAM tests
- Submission with tokens supported by Harvester and SAM ETF
- Transition to Tokens and Globus Retirement
 - CE upgrade campaigns for token support foreseen early next year



Selected items from Operations (1)

- Continued high activity for all experiments
- ATLAS
 - Frontier traffic redirected from IN2P3-CC and TRIUMF to CERN as of Nov 15
 - Rucio and FTS at CERN now support use of HTTPS with SRM
- CMS
 - WebDAV SAM test made mandatory
- PIC
 - Staging and FTS transfers were affected by LHCOPN issues
- RAL
 - Network interventions to implement network macro segmentation
- KIT
 - Tape storage not accessible until *log4j* mitigation is available (see next page)



Selected items from Operations (2)

Security

- Java log4j RCE 0-day vulnerability "Log4Shell"
 - Almost none of our Java MW appears to be affected
 - The perfSONAR Lookup Service is affected
 - The global instance operated by ESnet has been patched
 - Instructions have been provided for sites to patch private instances
 - Only ALICE use Java for grid operations:
 - An unaffected version of log4j was found loaded by MonALISA, but not actually used
 - The dependency was removed altogether on Saturday Dec 11
 - All MonALISA instances at sites have been restarted as well
