




CFI-NSERC coordination

- Alternating presence at biannual visits to CERN




2020 Innovation Fund – Diversity of team members

2020 Innovation Fund – Equity, diversity and inclusion key findings

- No indication of bias in the review process
- More women as team leaders and more junior researchers as team members in 2020
- Still a larger representation of mid- and late-career researchers as team members
- % of team members from the four designated groups is closer to the diversity profile of Canadian faculty members
- % of women as expert committee members is aligned with the % of women as team members
- Higher success rate for U15 institutions
- Low number of proposals in social sciences and humanities



Next Innovation Fund – Parameters under consideration

- Funding decision date
- Institutional envelopes (size of total envelope)
- Assessable equity, diversity and inclusion criterion/sub-criterion
- Expert committee meetings (virtual meetings, F2F meetings)
- Low participation in social sciences and humanities
