### **Summary of the meeting**

1. Kārlis Dreimanis (RTU) informs about the **CERN Baltic School**: the event in 2020 is cancelled due to Covid the restrictions. Participants and lecturers have been informed. COST funds are fully available until mid-April 2021, as per current COST rules;  
It was collegially agreed that the school should be postponed to 2021, and should take place during the summer in person. Financing will be allocated accordingly. The announcement will be updated in January, 2021.
2. Status update on **Industry engagement**: welcoming the Estonian ILO, Mrs Triin Kangro, as she started her ILO duties in July 2020. Separate meeting about the CBG Industry engagement with CERN will be organized in September. Activities such as the Roadshow and Industry days at CERN are postponed for now. However, the Estonian delegation, incl. representatives from industry, will visit CERN on 5<sup>th</sup>-7<sup>th</sup> October. Next week Prof. Mario Kadastik will organize the CBG Industry Group meeting.
3. Silva Vitola (RTU) on the progress of the **Study programme**: the study course mapping is on-going; the first complete draft of the study programme description is ready; the documentation will be finalized until the end of the year. The programme will be licensed until April 2021 and admission will start in September 2021 as scheduled.
4. The next **CBG General meeting** is planned in Riga, 12-13 October 2020. Status

to be updated at the end of September. Partners are ready and willing to meet on-line, if the travel restrictions persist.
