Context

Use of CERN's Indico must follow [CERN's data protection rules](#)

- A consequence of EU's GDPR

CERN provides [guide](#) for organizers (needs CERN login)

Example: need to ask at registration whether to mention in list of participants

vCHEP [provides](#) data protection notice, wonderful template for ACAT

"Zoom Bombing"

Common sport to hack large events by taking over screen and microphone to act inappropriately

Learning from "the world", vCHEP, CERN IT Security
